Whispering Farms is a 275-acre, master-planned community in Prosper offering a country setting without sacrificing luxury.

Whispering Farms offers riding training for those who want to learn the finer points of Hunter Jumper and Dressage.

It also offers the opportunity for casual riders to board horses for leisurely strolls on the weekends.

Beyond the training, the center can accommodate parties, receptions, private gatherings, overnight lodging, clinics, shows and horse sales.
